 - **Biology***, IPC, Chemistry, Physics, and Advanced science courses

- ❑ **Social Studies (4 Credits)**
 - World Geography ,World History, U.S. History*, U.S. Government (½ credit), and Economics (½ credit)

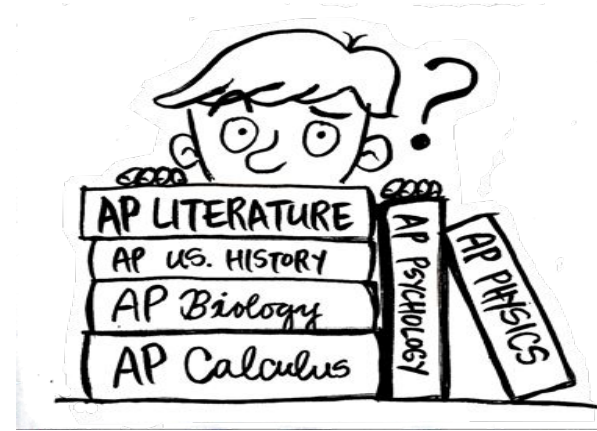
